OPEN is an initiative of CARE.

It aims to create an environment within churches where crisis pregnancy and post abortion concerns can be shared with grace and compassionate understanding.



Why such a ministry now?

One in three women in the UK will have had an abortion by the time they are 45. Inevitably, this will therefore be a part of the story for many in our churches.

Some women and their partners may have come to terms with their experience of abortion, but others still feel deeply affected, even if they felt it was the right decision at the time.

Many people might hesitate to tell people at church about their abortion, in case their response is unsympathetic or judgemental. This means they are left to deal with the hurt and pain on their own.

What does OPEN provide?

- In person and online training for church leaders to address this sensitive subject.
- Lectures for those studying in theological colleges.
- Seminars at Christian events.
- Speakers who can open up the conversation in church congregations.
- Post-abortion recovery weekend retreats.



One of the greatest pastoral challenges in the church today is how we support women who have to deal with the pain of an abortion.

This ministry brings tenderness, truth and hope to those who are dealing with this experience. OPEN can help local churches and individual women to find a pathway of healing in the midst of unspoken but deeplyfelt loss.
